#### **-POLICY-**

1. By school-leaving age, each student should have mastered the basic skills of literacy - should read, write, spell, and speak confidently and capably.
2. By school-leaving age, each student should know how to compute capably.
3. By school-leaving age, students should understand the scientific concepts which are practically applied in everyday living.
4. By school-leaving age, students should know the principles of good health and the need for good nutrition, for physical activity and for the prevention of disease and disability.
5. By school-leaving age, students should have a good understanding of Canada as a nation - the governmental bodies, the geographical features, the industrial and economic structure that will affect their daily living as adults.
6. By school-leaving age, students should understand the rights, responsibilities, privileges and penalties of citizens of Canada.
7. All students shall be encouraged to develop as many useful skills as possible.
8. All students shall be encouraged to develop democratic ideals - that is, to have a sense of fair and just treatment of others, to contribute to and participate in society in a way that is of benefit to all.
9. All students shall receive encouragement to develop a sense of purposefulness in fulfilling their own potential, to regard themselves in a positive way, and to learn to take charge of their own goals.
10. All students shall be encouraged to enjoy and participate in fine arts and cultural activities.
11. All students shall be encouraged to learn about the world in which they live and to appreciate and respect the diversity it offers.
