EDUCATION COMMITTEE

BC Lions Skills for Life Summit Presentation

The Superintendent introduced the Principal for Diamond Vale Elementary School Bruce Bidney and Diamond Vale grade 7 student Spencer Vaughn.

Mr. Bidney and Mr. Vaughn provided an overview of their extracurricular experience at the BC Lions Skills for Life Summit. He noted the BC Lions players discussed violence against women and bullying prevention.
