Our staff is working collaboratively with you to ensure that the best educational decisions are made for each student regarding their transitions to the next grade level, and that core skills focused on Literacy, Numeracy and natural exploration of learning is in place for each student.

We know this is not a perfect situation, but for the time being, this is our new reality. We want to express our gratitude and appreciation for the work you are doing and the efforts you continue to put in towards your child's success.

We recognize the challenges our families and community are facing; we know as a District and community that we will get through this together.
