Dear Graduate/Parent/Guardian,

First, I hope that all of you are safe, healthy and managing during this continued challenging time.

Now that May is upon us and we continue to be in a state of Provincial Emergency, it is apparent that commencement activities in our district, province and country will not look like they typically do. I want you to know that our high schools and district staff have been engaged in many conversations around Commencement in order to plan for alternatives to traditional ceremonies. We are looking at the options available to us, as well as looking at what other Districts are doing.
