When Kids Arrive in The Morning

They are greeted by caring staff who make sure that they are feeling well, and they are organized in a way that ensures safe distancing and contact. This includes kids who travel on the bus!

School entrances are carefully organized and monitored to ensure that everyone enters their classrooms in a safe way. Hands are washed and/or sanitized as soon as anyone comes into the building.



Hallways are set up with clear directions and "Stop, Look, Go" signs.



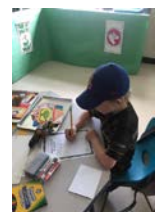
Washrooms are monitored for safety and cleanliness, with only one student in at a time and hourly cleanings. Anytime a student leaves the classroom there is hallway supervision and hand washing taking place when they return to their classroom.



Classrooms have been reorganized to ensure safe distancing and cleanliness.



Kids have their own workspaces, their own supplies, and keep their coats and backpacks with them.



Recess and lunch are staggered to maintain fewer numbers of kids being out and about after kids eat in their classrooms, and supervisors are always present to help kids be reminded of staying safe. Outdoor equipment is carefully monitored and cleaned so kids can play safely. High school students will have a place to eat and socialize safely or they may leave campus as per usual.



Above all adults are teaching students the things they can do in school that will keep them safer everywhere!
We have lots of visuals to remind kids about these things and we are already seeing some great new habits forming in our kids.

They will be teaching the adults soon!



At the end of the day students are once again safely sent on their way, after having had a great day with their friends and teachers.
