

Name of Game: Initial Sound Bingo



Targeted Skill: Initial letter/sound correspondence

Anticipated Outcome: Students will be able to identify the initial letter sounds in words

Grade Level: Kindergarten, Grade 1

Resources Required: Copies of Beginning Sound Bingo cards, picture cards, items to cover letters on bingo card

Explanation to Teacher (game construction): Print out copies of bingo cards and pictures, cut apart (laminates for durability). Gather small items (pom poms, beans, bingo chips, etc) to cover letters on the bingo board

Explanation To Teacher (how game works): Each student has their own Bingo card. All the picture cards are in a pile face down. One player turns over the top card, says the name of the picture, and identifies the sound and corresponding letter. Any player who has that letter on their Bingo card covers the letter with the small items.

Directions to Children: You are going to play a Bingo game. In this game you will get a turn to turn over a card. You need to say the name of the picture and then tell us what letter is at the beginning of that word. If you have that letter on your Bingo card you can cover it up with _____. Once all the letters on your Bingo card are covered you can call out "BINGO!".
