Firstly, we would like to extend our deepest sympathies to all those that have been affected by the recent flooding in both our Princeton and Merritt communities. We would like to remind students and families that application deadlines are fast approaching for most Post-Secondary institutions (January 15th-30th).

Most applications in BC are done through a central website known as EducationPlannerBC. Here, you are required to provide some basic information, select your program(s), and in most cases pay an application fee (application to NVIT is free). After applying, you will likely receive a confirmation/introductory e-mail requesting further information. Please read this carefully as requests for additional documentation vary between institutions. In almost every case, you will be required to submit an official transcript and self report grades for current classes. Transcripts must be ordered through the Ministry of Education website as your high school does not send transcripts on your behalf. For one on one support with your application, please consider e-mailing a member of our team to set up a virtual appointment.

Please note that the Career and Life Connections 12 course activities have been pushed back and are now due **January 20th, 2022**. Students can access these activities by logging in to www.myblueprint.ca/sd58 and following the instructions and "How-To" videos. We also encourage students to continue working towards their 30 hours of Career Exploration.
