## Invitation to French Immersion Celebration

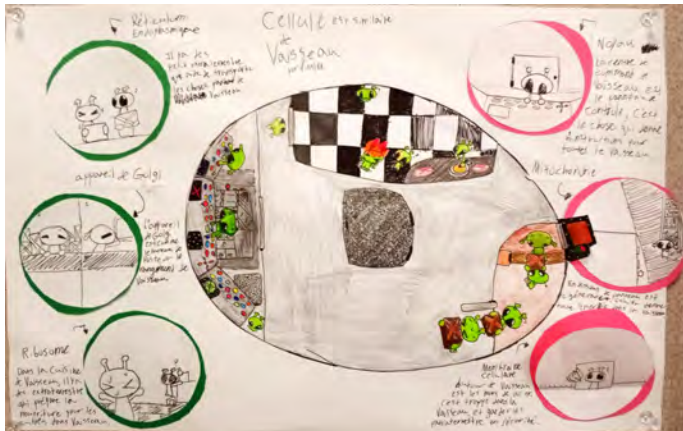
